What Can I Do to Prevent Child Sexual Abuse?

- Teach your child about his/her body, including the correct names for private parts. Talk with your child about sex, sexual abuse, and self-protection, based on age and maturity level.
- Understand healthy sexual development in children and youth so you know when some behavior is unusual.
- Learn and address the risk factors or warning signs in an adult, adolescent, or a child who may become sexually abusive.
- Insist that groups involving your children train their staff to prevent, recognize, and react responsibly to child sexual abuse.
- Know that child sexual abuse includes both touching and non-touching behaviors.
- Talk with legislators about the importance of funding more sexual abuse prevention efforts.

about

Since its origin in 1975, Prevent Child Abuse Iowa (PCA Iowa) has had the fundamental – and critically important – mission of ending child abuse in the entire state of Iowa. PCA Iowa is the only statewide advocacy organization with the single-minded goal of preventing child abuse before it occurs.

The core assumption supporting this mission is that child abuse is preventable and that children can be made safe from it if families receive appropriate and timely social support, respite child care, and education. Social support breaks down the isolation that many parents experience and helps them build the connections they need. Respite child care enables them to survive periods of high stress. Education teaches children how to protect themselves and teaches parents how to communicate effectively and manage better their children's behavior.

silent auction

1. The silent auction opens for bidding at 6 p.m. and closes at 8 p.m.
